## 1. Pylons Across Lincolnshire

National Grid has launched a <u>second round of consultation on their proposed Grimsby to Walpole pylon route</u>, and an initial consultation on another route through the south of Lincolnshire from <u>Weston Marsh in South Holland to East Leicestershire</u>.

The council is putting together its own response to the consultation and I know that residents are hugely against these plans, from speaking to people on the doorstep. I urge everyone with concerns, to complete the National Grid surveys, or visit an information event and make their voice heard.

## 2. Lincolnshire Nuclear Waste Plan Withdrawn

Lincolnshire County Council's new Executive has voted to withdraw from Nuclear Waste Services' Community Partnership – quashing plans to store nuclear waste in the county.

Plans that earmarked Theddlethorpe on the coast as a possible site for underground nuclear waste storage, were first raised four years ago.
